

#### **Town of Darien Tax Bills**

The tax bills will be mailed out around the end of the first week in December.

TAX PAYMENT: Please mail payment to Richard Logterman, Treasurer, Town of Darien, N2826 Foundry Road, Darien Wisconsin. 53114. <u>DO NOT USE PO BOX. This will either delay</u> <u>or we may not receive your payment!</u> Please check the address and make sure the amount is correct before mailing your tax payment. Enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope to receive a receipt. You may also pay in person at the Town Treasurer's office or use the drop box at the Town Hall, N2826 Foundry Road, Darien.

#### Treasurer's Hours Tuesday & Thursday 5 pm – 7 pm Special Hours:

#### Thursday, December 31, 1 pm – 4 pm

The Town Clerk is able to collect your tax bill during her normal business hours and stamp it received and use the copy machine to give you a copy of her receiving it; but only the Town Treasurer does the official receipting. The treasurer would mail you the official receipt in the mail.

Real Estate Taxes may be paid in two installments, with the first installment due to the Town Treasurer on or before January 31, 2016. The second half must be paid to the County Treasurer on or before July 31, 2016. As a reminder the Walworth County Treasurer's office **DOES NOT** send out reminders for your second half payment. ### Dog Licenses

Town of Darien Municipal Code requires that all dogs five months and older as of January 1, 2016 must be licensed. Please print out the license application from the Town's website or fill out the one in your tax bill. Please return the application with the proper amount either in person, mail it in, or a drop box is available at the Town Hall. **We do not take credit cards.** 

#### Walworth County Sheriff's Department

In the month of October, the Walworth County Sheriff's Department responded to 288 calls in the Town of Darien. This would break down to 9.3 calls a day. Some of the calls include: EMS & fire calls, controlled burn, traffic stops, extra patrol, business checks, noise complaint, assist motorist, livestock loose, reckless driver, sign down, provide security, fraud, abandoned vehicle, debris in roadway, criminal damage to property, 911 open line, vandalism, rescue illness, welfare checks, animal miscellaneous, dead deer, suspicious, disorderly conduct fighting, domestic abuse, fire-alarm, bar checks, disorderly conduct – person, MVA – hit & run, warrant attempt, electronic monitoring check, civil process, loud music, OVWI, prisoner transport, and threats.

#### from Driveways

Whereas, leaving snow and other material on roadways or right of way is illegal. Performing these activities can lead to accidents resulting in property damage, bodily injury, and even death. These activities are prohibited by Wisconsin State Statutes 86.01, 86.022, 346.94 (5) (7) and 941.01. Following of these statutes will avoid penalty and liability, and will help keep town road travel safe for everyone. The Walworth County Sheriff Department will be working with the Public Works

Department to enforce law. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$100.

#### Village Board Adopts the 2016 Budget

After a Public Hearing on November 9<sup>th</sup>, the Village Board of Trustees adopted the 2016



budget and set the Village's portion of the property tax levy. The Tax rate for the Village is \$13.72 per \$1,000 of assessed value. This represents an increase of \$0.12 per \$1,000 of value from 2015 budget. The entire budget is available for review on the Village's website: <u>www.darienwi.com</u>. #### 2015 Notice: Snow & Ice Removal Violation

The owners/occupants of Village properties are required to remove all snow and ice which has fallen or accumulated upon the sidewalk in front of the property. If the owner/occupant fails to clear the snow and ice from these sidewalks, the Village Public Works Department will clear these and the owner of the property will be levied a special tax.

Snow cannot be deposited in the Village Streets. If snow is deposited in the street, the Village may assess the owner/occupant a fee sufficient to reimburse the Village for the cost of the removal of such snow.

Penalties: The number of offences are based on a seasonal year which runs October 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>. First Offense: \$50; Second: \$100.00 Third: not to exceed \$150.00 plus costs.

The Ten Tips Are:

Things To Do:

- Know who you are dealing with.
- Know that wiring money is like sending money (It is untraceable).
- Read your monthly banking/financial statements (looking for unauthorized usage).
- After a disaster, only give to established charities (Salvation Army, etc.).
- Talk with your doctor before you buy health products or treatments.
- Remember there's no sure thing in investing.

Things Not To Do:

- Don't send money to someone you don't know.
- Don't agree to deposit a check or wire money back.
- Don't reply to messages for personal or financial information.
- Don't play a foreign lottery.

In closing, if you have a door to door salesperson attempting to solicit business please contact the Police Department at 262-728-6311, so we may confirm they registered with the Village. This helps to ensure only legitimate business is being conducted in our communities.
