# Town of Darien becomes a Substation for the Walworth Sheriff Department

The Walworth County Sheriff's Office patrol division deputies will begin to work fulltime out of four town halls beginning on Sunday October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2016. Darien Town hall is one of them. The others include Lyons, Troy, and Whitewater Townships. Currently the Sheriff's deputies use the Darien Town hall part time as one of their substations. Two deputies per shift will be assigned to each of the four town halls. As always the Sheriff's Office is available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. The purpose of this decentralization is to provide community oriented police services as well as a quicker response time between shifts. The majority of the deputies will continue to work out of the Sheriff's Office in Elkhorn. Now that Dairen will have dedicated deputies patrolling the area full time on each shift, we hope you will get to know them and feel comfortable working together with them to make our community safer. ## Use of a Cellular Phone while driving in a Construction Zone – could cost you \$\$

As of October 1, 2016 the Wisconsin Act 308 prohibits a person from driving a motor vehicle while using a cellular or other wireless telephone in a construction zone where persons engage in work are at risk from traffic, except to report an emergency. The prohibition does not apply to the use of a voiceoperated or hands-free device if the person does not use his or her hands to operate the device, except to activate or deactivate a feature or function of the device. The prohibition includes using the telephone for a purpose other than communication. A person who violates this prohibition may be required to forfeit not less than \$20 nor more than \$40 for a first offense and not less \$50 nor more than \$100 for a second or subsequent offense within one year.
