Absentee ballots will be available in the Clerk's Office beginning October 17 – November 3, from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.; on Friday, November 4, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.. No early voting on November 5th, 6th, and 7th. Please plan ahead. Also, be prepared to show a photo I.D. before receiving a ballot when voting in person.

If you want to receive an absentee ballot by mail – please go to the Town's website and fill out a GAB 121 application. When mailing the completed application back to the Town Clerk; a copy of your photo ID must accompany the GAB 121 to receive a ballot by mail.

If you are a new resident of the Town and have lived here 10 days prior to the election and would like to vote in the Presidential race, November 8, 2016, stop by the Town Hall and the Town Clerk will help you get registered. The forms are also located on Town's website under Election Information.
