2015 Taxes Second Installment Due

If you did not pay your 2015 Taxes in full, your second installment payment is **due on or before July 31** to the Walworth County Treasurer. The Walworth County Treasurer's office is located on 100 W. Walworth Street in Elkhorn. Their mailing address is PO Box 1001, Elkhorn, WI 53121. County Treasurer's Office also accepts Visa, Master Card, and Discover. Payment by credit card can be done in person or on their website. There is a 2.49% charge for this service. The Town Treasurer <u>does not</u> accept this payment – this must be sent by mail or dropped off in Elkhorn. If you need to help locating your tax bill; either go on Walworth County's web site or call the Town Clerk.

Partisan Primary – Tuesday, August 9th Early Voting Begins in the Clerk's Office July 25th – August 5th

No Absentee Voting from August $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ Please remember that this is a Partisan Primary and as such you may only vote for a candidate in ONE Political Party. If you vote for more than one political party your vote will be voided and you will need to request a new ballot. The Town Clerk will be testing voting equipment on Wednesday, August 6^{th} at 10 am at the Town Hall.

***** Attention college students if you are turning 18 on or before the 8th of November and would like to vote absentee for the President Race, come register to vote before going to college. You will also be asked to fill out an absentee application and your ballot will be sent directly to you from the Town Clerk. I will need to keep a photo ID on file for you to receive a ballot by mail.

ATV

Information Public Safety

- 1. Only ATV's and UTV's are allowed on the ATV Routes.
- 2. Your ATV must be registered.
- 3. You must be at **least 16 years** of age to operate an ATV on a route.
- 4. You must have passed an operator's safety course if you are born after 1986.
- 5. All riders under the age of 18 while operating on a route **MUST WEAR A HELMET**.
- 6 All ATV's must operate on the pavement; not in the ditches.
- You must obey all traffic laws; which include speed limits, stop signs, and driving on correct side of the road.

ATV routes **are not** the same as trails. Mini bikes and golf carts **are not allowed on** ATV's Routes. The Sheriff Department **WILL ISSUE** tickets if they see any violations. The addition of an AVT Route on Town Roads is being discussed at the Town Board Meetings.

Walworth County Sheriff's Department

In the month of April, the Walworth County Sheriff's Department responded to 234 calls in the Town of Darien. This breaks down to 7.5 calls a day. Some of the calls include: EMS & fire calls, 4 - 911 hangs, 9 - 911 open lines, 4 abandoned vehicles, 49 business checks, 10 controlled burns, 19 assist motorist, 5 civil process, 1 dead deer, 2 dog at large, 12 reckless drivers, 1 sign down, 43 traffic stops, 4 welfare checks, 1 trouble with kids, 1 theft, 2 noise complaints, 2 OVWI, and 4 debris in roadway.

ELECTION 2016

August 9, 2016 Partisan Primary **Election Information**

The Partisan Primary Election will be held on August 9, 2016 in the Village of Darien. Contests on the ballot include primaries for the following offices: United States Senator, Representative in Congress – District 1, Representative to the State Assemble - District 31, Walworth County District Attorney, County Clerk, County Treasurer, and County Register of Deeds. The winners of these primary contests will move on to the Presidential and General Election, which will take place on November 8, 2016. Please remember that voters may only vote within one party: Republican, Democratic, Constitution, Libertarian, or Wisconsin Green, during the Partisan Primary.

Village residents will vote at Village Hall in the Board Room. The polls will be open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm Remember to bring your photo identification card to vote. New Village residents or those who have changed their name or moved since the last election may register to vote on Election Day and will need to bring a valid form of proof of residence to do so. If you have questions about photo identification or proof of residence, please contact Village Hall or check the Village's website: www.darienwi.com.

Voters who cannot make it to Village Hall on Election Day may vote by absentee ballot during the two weeks prior to the Election at Village Hall or may request that a ballot be mailed to them. In-person absentee voting will take place on Monday, July 25th through Friday, August 5th during regular office hours (8:00 am to 5:00 pm).

Correction regarding Deduct Meters

In previous newsletters, the Village encouraged individuals to pick up deduct meters from Village Hall for garden/lawn-watering and pool-filling. The articles included information regarding the \$10 service fee and \$10 deposit but neglected to mention the monthly rental fee. Our apologies for this omission. In addition to the service fee and the refundable deposit, the month rental fee for a deduct meter is \$5.70.
